



## "Addressing Garbage Burning in India"

(Collective Inputs from 335,000 strong Swachh Bharat Circle)

- Burning garbage openly should be completely banned and the ban enforced by municipality and police
- 2. Checks should be made by roping in Citizen Reporting with Municipal/Police enforcement
- 3. The organic and hazardous garbage should be burnt through an incinerator to avoid air pollution
- 4. RWAs and other resident bodies should make sure that the residents and their staff are strictly advised on not burning garbage
- 5. Large compost pits/bins should be maintained in every society/colony
- 6. RWAs should be authorised to fine anyone found burning garbage
- 7. Awareness should be improved to reduce burning of rubber/plastic materials openly
- 8. People should be educated about the diseases caused by burning waste in open
- 9. Private vendors should be engaged for door to door garbage pickup free of cost or at a very nominal rate
- 10. Every district should have at least one garbage treatment plant
- 11. Municipalities, MCGM should provide helpline numbers to report this, and an 'action taken' status should immediately be conveyed
- 12. General awareness programs must be held frequently on Radio/TV.
